

## 820 RCACS VACCINATION REQUIREMENT Oct 2021

820 RCACS Parents/Guardians and Cadets: the Halton Catholic District School Board (our landlord for St Benedict school where we parade in person) has released its most current Rules and Regulations for tenants/users:

1. All participants 12 years and older must be double vaccinated and provide proof of such (OR 645/21).
2. Medical exemptions must follow Ontario Regulation 645/21. Documentation must be on official letterhead, clearly stating the medical reason for exemption, and the time period for which the exemption is in effect. I have included the Ontario Government guidelines which should be provided to your medical practitioner for guidance, along with a premade exemption form should you require such.
3. There are no exemptions for religious reasons.
4. The responsibility for screening “proof of vaccination” has been delegated to each tenant/permit holder. Accordingly, 820 will screen all cadets and staff in order to comply with the school board’s directive. For the proof of vaccination, this will only need to be done once and 820 will keep a record that your cadet is approved for entry. 820 will not keep/store any medical information. Paper vaccination records or downloaded PDFs to your smart phone will be accepted (at least until the ON vaccine passport/barcode rolls out later in Oct).
5. Covid pre-screenings for cadets (before every parade night) will also have to be completed by 820 staff prior to entry. We are working on a quick, downloadable form that your cadet can simply bring with them on parade nights. We will have paper copies on hand for those that forget.
6. Parents/guardians are not permitted in the school building, regardless of vaccination status. This is a main requirement of the school board to limit contact as much as possible.
7. NOTE: the aforementioned in no way refers to DND/CF policy. These are rules and regulations put in place by our landlord that we must abide by in order to use their facilities. As school bookings are very limited and hard to secure, 820 will comply 100% with HCDSB guidelines to ensure a continued mutual working relationship. Thank you in advance for your understanding and compliance.

Excerpt from HCDSB Covid Rules and Regulations Oct 2021:

Any visitors attending indoor facility bookings are required to be **fully vaccinated or medically exempt**, in accordance with Ontario Regulation 645/21. User groups are responsible for ensuring that proof of vaccination and identity are verified for all participants prior to entering Board facilities.

- User groups will ensure that visitor lists and information are maintained and readily available to be provided to public health for contact tracing purposes in accordance with all applicable legislation, including the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
- No spectators are to enter the facilities, including parents. Only participants and coaches/workers are allowed in the facility.
